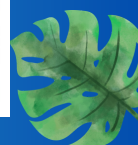

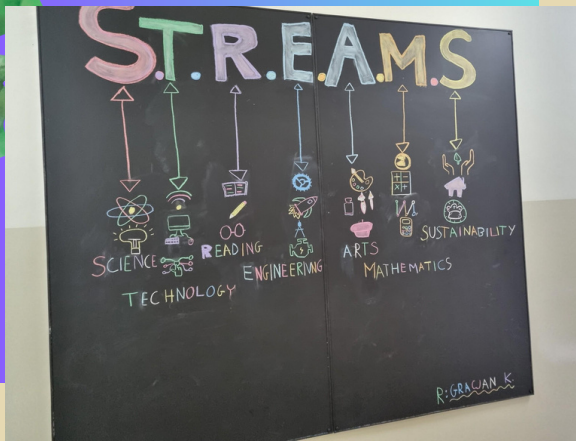
## START UP 2023 - CLIMATE CHANGE

Our goal is to develop innovations regarding environmental protection in our city. The first idea is to design new educational and sensory routes in our Chrobry Park.
